## Statement of Purpose & Direction for Production

Love stories are always entertaining. But a threadbare romance following a clichéd formula is dull and boring. So, we are always on the lookout for a new and original love story. In this tale about a man and woman who have been dating for a long time but weren't able to communicate properly, getting entangled with a creature from Mars allows them to see the love they have for each other. Anyone who has been in a relationship can relate to the misunderstandings and conflict in this story. A film that presents a cheerful and heartwarming universal love story to all those in love! A perfect combination of science fiction and romantic comedy, this unique love story "The Weirdo From Mars" has universal elements that viewers can 100% sympathize with.

As a film production company that has successfully completed Korea-China coproduction projects such as the film "The Witness" and the TV series "Legend Hero", MoonWatcher has great interest in coproduction with Japan. We are currently taking our first steps in coproduction with Japan through the Japanese adaptation of the film "Blind"; we plan to prepare quality coproduction projects with Japan starting with "The Weirdo From Mars". Because "The Weirdo From Mars" is an SF romantic comedy, this film will be an interesting romantic comedy with familiar elements for Japanese viewers who enjoy the SF fantasy genre.
