Only one month until the start of TIFFCOM 2009, which will be marking its sixth year (date: October 20-22, 2009) (Organized by: Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, Japan Association for International Promotion of the Moving Image (UNIJAPAN), and Japan Institute of Development and Promotion for Pictures).

We would like to announce the highly recommended sales line up from the exhibiting companies. These films will be screened by exhibiting companies for buyers during the three day period of October 20-22 at a total of three venues: TOHO Cinema's Roppongi Hills Screen 4, and screening rooms 1 and 2 located on the 49th floor of Roppongi Hills Mori Tower.

The four films "Zero Focus (*Zero no Shoten*)" (Toho), "Feel the Wind" (Shochiku), "Tenshi no Koi" (Gaga), and "I Give My First Love to You" (Nippon Television Network), which will also be shown as Special Screenings at the 22nd Tokyo International Film Festival being held simultaneously with TIFFCOM, are the highly recommended lineup from the film distribution companies.

Also, a unique lineup and films to be screened from Japan are continually being added, such as "Black Kaisha ni Tsutometerun daga, mo Ore wa Genkai kamoshirena" (Asmik Ace), "Furimun in Okinawa" (Kadokawa Pictures), "A God Husband" (Toei), "The Wonderful World of Captain Kuhio" (Showgate), and "Abashiri Ikka The Movie" (Klockworx). A rich variety of films will be available from overseas, such as films from China and "Yellow Sheep River" (Joint Entertainment, Taiwan) which won the "Best Documentary" at Taipei Film Festival 2009.
